Jim presented a list of 9 people who requested membership on the Huntington Energy Committee. Jim moved to accept the list of members as presented, second by Doug; approved unanimously.

Yogi reported on progress of the new garage floor and office. The floor was poured with drainage to a separator tank from the two wash bays. The garage floor as well as upgrading wiring and plumbing is in response to VOSHA requirements. The garage improvements expenses are being paid from the Highway Reserve Fund voted at Town Meeting. Bill Wixen's last day as a part-time employee will be this Wednesday. The need for repair or replacement of the garage roof and insulation was discussed. A suggestion was made to have Efficiency Vermont evaluate situation and then obtain estimates for the cost. The expense will become part of the Capital Budget and should be included for implementation within two years.

Heidi Racht reported that a Boy Scout working on his Eagle Scout badge will be requesting a letter of support from the Selectboard for his proposed project.

Ed W. reported that David Roberts, a Chittenden County Metropolitan Planning Organization senior planner, sent memo concerning preliminary data from the Traffic Calming Study. Speed recording data from north of the Lower Village and north of the Center confirmed excessive vehicle speed and further study is being planned. He requested that the Selectboard organize a committee of citizens to work with CCMPO to evaluate traffic calming alternatives and determine appropriate solutions. The Times Ink will print the information and request next week.

Doug moved to go into executive session, seconded by Jim. Unanimously approved at 8:05 pm. Doug moved to go out of executive session, Ed B. seconded. Unanimously approved at 9:05 pm. No action was taken.
