Correspondence / Updates:

- Jim Hildebran reported that the Energy Committee will have literature available at Town Meeting. Also, the Committee obtained a grant to provide free energy saving compact light bulbs for citizens attending Town Meeting and willing to complete an energy survey.
- Doug reported that the Traffic Calming Committee will receive the progress report from the MPO consultants on Wednesday. The committee will meet on February 27 to discuss the report.
- Doug discussed the need for a new computer for the Zoning Administrator. Bill Hegman has offered a cast-off, relatively current computer to the Town. Doug also spoke of the need for a new Town credit card since One-Care, the computer protection software used by the Town, only accepts payment by credit card. Ed W. will speak with Dan and will obtain a new card.
- Letters responding to two citizen letters of complaint about snow plowing will be sent to the individuals from the Selectboard.
- A letter was sent from the Selectboard to Ken Pillsbury concerning the taking of Town gravel for personal use. Ken expressed his concern to the Town Administrator, in person, stating that as a long time resident he was disappointed that a member of the Selectboard had not spoken to him in person. A copy of the letter sent by the Selectboard and a summary of Ken's concerns are available in the Administrator Office.
