The meeting began in Maplewood Cemetery at 9:10 am where the trustees discussed repairs to the road, signage, clean up, mowing, tree removal, flag placement and the sunken areas at the front of the cemetery.

The Trustees agreed to solicit daylilies to put in the wooded area cleared last summer. Purpose is to make the area look nice and also less inviting to people to dump things.

Lot sales for the newly marked sections can begin as soon as the map is received from Ross Ogilvie.

Removal of pine trees in back of cemetery – Terry Boyle will mark trees to keep; the rest will be offered to residents to dig and take. Then, the field will be cut. Troy Liberty has offered to do this.

The Board decided to enforce the no artificial flowers, etc., policy since the cemetery is starting to look unkempt.

Memorial Day flags will be placed by Trustees Racht and Rachampbell and Advisor Hill. Other volunteers will be solicited. Date to be determined.
