<a)Trading Dryers for close lines> Dave did some analysis to figure out how much it would cost to come up with some fliers and other printed information for public distribution. the figure came in at around \$700. The folks at Richmond home supply were not interested in helping with this. We discussed putting all of the current info on the town website. Larry mentioned it could be fun to create the laundry write-up.
