Ed Booth called the meeting to order at 7:00.

**Reports/Guests:**

- Residents of Huntington Woods attended to express their continuing concerns about the noise and outside fire problems associated with Ken Marquis. Questions about the distance a fire must be from neighboring properties and whether Marquis actually had a business at his residence. Cathleen Gent, Zoning Administrator, will look into both points to determine if the Town has any jurisdiction to control such activities. Cathleen again noted the need to have emails and phone calls from residents each time they have a noise complete. Ken Russin, Fire Warden, has been to Marquis' home a number of times about smoking fire complaints. Russin said he has only seen hardwood pallets being burn, but did not know what materials were periodically being burned in a "wood stove" located in Marquis' garage. Russin will not approve any burn permits until the questions are answered.
- Bonnie Gordon again asked about her driveway problem and what the Town would do to help her. A Culvert was purchased many years ago, but was never installed. Yogi and Joe Segale will meet with Bonnie at her home and determine what should be done.
- Youngsters and adults representing the Skate Park Project attended to discuss their plans to build the park. They have poled the neighborhood in the Center and had all but one reply as positive comments. Kevin Cunningham is the spokes person for both the Recreation Committee and the project. The Selectboard encourage the project development and requested written plans and anticipated sources of funding.
- Yogi, Road Foreman, reported that he was finishing culvert work on Bridge Street, and one he had not known about on Economou Road. He then has to replace culverts on Taft and Camels Hump Roads. The Road Crew will then proceed with brush cutting which will be done on specific roads and the dates for

cutting will be advertised in public places. Residents who want wood chips from the brush cutting should phone Yogi at 434-2710. Residents closest to the current cutting work will receive priority.

- Ed Wildman, Town Administrator, reported that contractors were evaluating the drainage problem around the Town Office building.

**Action Items:**

- Ed Wildman, Town Administrator, reported that Parent construction will secure the southwest wingwall on Bridge #10 (Beane on Main Road) for \$13,900. The work will be completed this year. Jim Christiansen moved and Joe Segale seconded the proposal. Unanimous vote.
- Mike Ramsey reported for the Fire Department that Mat LaBounty bid to remove and dispose of the old roof insulation. Joe Segale moved to have Bugby Insulation, Inc. and Mat LaBounty complete the project contingent on insulating the porloins and the project does not exceed \$42,500. Jim Christiansen seconded. Unanimous vote.
- The proposed Noise Ordinance was discussed and tabled for revisions.

**Adjourn:** Jim Hildebran moved to adjourn, seconded by Jim Christiansen. Unanimous vote: 8:48 pm.
