1. Huntington town budget passed, having been increased by \$1177).
2. Town sand-shed addition to house equipment passed.
3. Use of \$30,000 to reduce tax rate failed
4. For two years, Town Meeting Day schedule will be:
2015: 9 am School Meeting, followed by Town Meeting
2016: 9 am Town Meeting, followed by School Meeting
5. Reduction of Planning Commission from seven to five members
6. Support moving to DRB (Development Review Board)

At School Meeting:

1. Huntington school budget passed
2. allocated \$33,000 to make capital improvements

This was the longest Town Meeting Day in recent history, with the Town Meeting ending after 3 pm and the School Meeting beginning at 3:20 and ending just before 6 pm. (Moderator Britt Cummings told the assemblage that he had to leave at 6 pm as he had another commitment.)
